

	<p>1. What does this sign represent? A = Green Cross Code</p>
	<p>2. What do we need to think about before crossing any road? A = Where we are going to cross the road that's safe and where we can see clearly up and down the road.</p>
	<p>3. Why do we need to stop? A = To allow use time to check if the road is free from traffic to allow us to cross safely.</p>
	<p>4. Is it safe to stand on the edge of the kerb like this when crossing a road? Please explain your answer and what you should do. A = No because a car may pass by you closely and hit you with a wing mirror or a lorry may past you at speed and potentially drag you into the road as it's slip stream passes you. Always stan back away from the kerb.</p>
	<p>5. Where do you look and what are you looking for? A = Look Left and Right for oncoming traffic and when there's enough space to cross the road safely</p>
	<p>6. What are you listening for? A = Any type of mode of transport that uses the road.</p>
	<p>7. Name things you are looking and listening for? A = Cars, Vans, Taxi's, Buses, Lorries, Waste recycling vehicle, Tractors, motorbikes, emergency service vehicles, horses, cyclists, electric/ hybrid vehicles.</p>
	<p>8. When crossing a road should you walk or run? Explain your answer. A = Always walk as you may trip or fall when running across a road.</p> <p>8a. What should you still be doing whilst crossing the road? A = Looking and Listening for cars etc.</p>
	<p>9. Should you ride a bicycle across a road when crossing? Explain your answer A = You should always dismount and walk your bicycle across a road again this is in case you fall off whilst riding it across. The exception to this is you can ride a bike across a toucan crossing only.</p>
